Col d'Orcia is another one of the big producers who has made an excellent 2008, especially given the difficult conditions (in the form of hail) in the vineyard. It's a supple southern style all right, with plenty of texture and sweet reds fruits, but the altitude of the vineyard (250-400 metres) adds freshness, too. Ripe, yet balanced. Drink: 2015-22
