The color of the 2010 remains a bright ruby with violet reflections. The aromatics are just lovely, with fresh flowers, crushed fresh herbs, wet stones and ripe cherries present. It's a lovely feminine ball room dancer. On the palate, the wine exudes that same sense of class; though it displays more brawn given the vintage. This is full bodied, with juicy fresh wild berry fruit, mineral dust tones, leaf tobacco, fresh sage and anise. The tannins are intricately woven and not at all intrusive.
