Beautiful aromas of glacéed cherries, blood oranges and sweet tobacco are on display here, and the mouthfeel is super silky due to integrated tannins and good body. On the finish, excellent acidity for the vintage comes into play, making this dusty and fresh at the same time. A traditional Brunello di Montalcino and excellent. Drink in 2016.
